

Rundale Palace – Bauska Castle

Rundale Palace with Charming French-style park is one of the most outstanding monuments of Baroque and Rococo art in Latvia, was built by Duke Biron in two periods, from 1736 until 1740 and from 1764 until 1768, as Russian Empire Catherine II summer residence. Rundale Palace architect is Bartolomeo Rastrelli, created paintings on the ceilings and walls while sculptor Johann Michael Graff from Berlin made stucco decorations on a background of artificial marble.

The oldest part of Bauska Castle is the Livonian Order Fortress, built specially for the use of firearms. It is a characteristic example of Latvia's 15th-17th century military construction. The residence-type castle, fortified with bastions, fortification walls and earthen ramparts, is a more recent structure.
